Kenya wildlife Service has acquired a fleet of 26 vehicles to be used for rapid response to human-wildlife conflicts and parks management.

Twenty one of these will be used to facilitate officers address human wildlife conflict, four for security operations, while one will be used by researchers.

The vehicles form part of KWS force modernization programme which is in tandem with the organization's strategic plan 2017-2022.

The vehicles will also complement other measures in conservation activities, including the recently launched 43 kilometers wildlife fence in Rumuruti, Laikipia County, the ongoing Mount Kenya fencing, Meru Park, and the proposed Alia Kasigau fence in TaitaTaveta County.

It is anticipated that the motor vehicles will significantly aid in reducing human-wildlife conflicts, improve security and research around the country.

## KWS Acquires a New Fleet of Vehicles To Aid Conservation

The new fleet of vehicles was procured from internal savings from revenue generated by the organization. Earlier this year KWS acquired another 26 vehicles through assistance from USAID.

Tourism and Wildlife Cabinet Secretary, Najib Balala officially handed over the vehicles to field stations across the country at a brief ceremony at KWS headquarters in Nairobi.

He said his ministry in consultation with the national Treasury will explore ways of enhancing financial allocation to KWS to purchase necessary equipment for conservation activities and to facilitate pending compensation claims.

The Cabinet Secretary

added his ministry will work with other stakeholders in the wildlife conservation and tourism industry through structured engagement in seeking solutions to mitigate human-wildlife conflicts, which remains one of the biggest challenges in wildlife conservation in Kenya.

"My ministry takes a keen interest in wildlife conservation, protection and management because it is an important pillar that supports the "Big four" government agenda", he said.

He added "control of humanwildlife conflicts through crop protection and predation from wild carnivores cushions farmers from crop and livestock losses, ensuring food security in the country". The Cabinet secretary challenged KWS to deploy all resources at her disposal to address human-wildlife conflicts as it was giving the organization a bad name.

He also urged the management to strive to reengineer the organization's parks and reserves in terms of products and services offered to stave off stiff competition from private conservancies for tourists.

Mr. Balala reiterated that conservation, protection and research of wildlife are important for promoting tourism, which is a critical sector in generating foreign exchange and employment that the country dearly needs



## The Actress Who Broke Conventional Barriers On-Screen

Here's proof that a Hindi film heroine's career does not go kaput when she gets married: Legendary actress Nutan, writes DINESH RAHEJA.

Nutan, it seems, always had this ability to pull off the unconventional.

Her mother Shobhana Samarth (the 1940s star) didn't expect a celebrity career for her teenage daughter.

As a child Nutan was nothing like the roles she did in the movies, in fact her mother called Nutan "my saint"

Nutan's childhood complex considering she didn't look like the other girls of her age as was skinny, tall and gangly at a time when beauty meant petite and plump.

So when she was offered her role, everyone in her family was surprised.

True, Nutan had essayed a small role as a child artiste in the mid-40s Nal Damayanti.

But Shobhana was surprised when biggie Chandulal Shah offered to cast her adolescent daughter opposite stars like Raj Kapoor and Dilip Kurnar in his next film.

Shobhana finally detected that special, lit-up quality in 14-yearold Nutan's eyes

Chandulal Shah's offer fell through.

But Shobhana Samarth launched Nutan as an adult artiste in the aptly-named film, Hamari Beti (1950).

It was a show of feminist fervour: Shobhana produced and directed the movie

The film didn't make Nutan a star but the very next year, the success of Nagina and Hum Log ensured middle-level stardom for Nutan.

Nagina was an adults-only film Interestingly, a diligent watchman outside a theatre screening the film barred Nutan from watching her own film because she was still underage!

Despite her early success, Nutan was often dismissed as 'too thin'.

For the next few years, she lidn't make much headway: Shikwa was stalled, thus nipping her bid to act opposite megastar Dilip Kumar (they make an exquisite couple in the rare footage salvaged).

And her big films like Shabab (costarring Bharat Bhushan) with Naushad's mellifluous music were disappointments.

At this stage, the mercurial Shobhana took an unprecedented step: She sent Nutan to La Chatelaine, a finishing school in Switzerland.

Nutan explained, "I was terribly thin and within the industry there was a joke that if you want to

draw Nutan, just draw a straight

"My mother even feared that perhaps I had TB. So, at 17, despite the fact that I had so many film offers, my mother sent to a finishing school in Switzerland.

"The one year that I spent in Switzerland was the happiest in my life. I could play, study, be free, and catch up with what I missed in my teenage years.

"When I returned to India, was 40 pounds heavier, and then began a wonderful phase

When Nutan returned, filmmakers looked at the exotic, Westernized heroine with new

She landed the title role in Amiya Chakraborty's Seema about a juvenile delinquent at the cusp of childhood and womanhood.

Her eyes flashed fire in the intricately-sung Manmohana bade ihoothe picturised on her (even singer Lata Mangeshkar was impressed).

Her character's stricken soul was brought to heart-breaking life as she fought a moral maelstrom while hungrily inching towards a fallen coin.

Seema was a hit and she won Award.

She never looked back

Nutan was also way ahead of her time, being crowned Miss India in 1951, she went on to become one of the few actresses bold enough to wear a bikin

Here was an actress who could change gears with well-oiled efficiency: She was the very essence of featherweight froth in films like Paying Guest and Anadi and made a splash by posing in a swimsuit for Delhi Ka Thug.

Nutan also gave cry-from-the-soul performances in Sone Ki Chidiya (as an exploited actress) and in Bimal Roy's classic, Sujata (as a girl who strives to

cross the chasm of caste and be fully accepted by her foster family).

In 1959, the year in which she rode high, Nutan did the unconventional and married naval Lieutenant-Commander Rajnish Behl.

In 1960 she starred opposite Raj Kapoor again Manmohan Desai's Chhalia.

In a film review at the time, Filmfare wrote: "As the unfortunate disowned by her relatives for no fault of hers, Nutan puts over a superb and memorable portr

As an artiste she was magnanimous. K Asif's *Mughal-E-Azam* (1960) was first offered to her.

She was honest enough to understand that she didn't suit the character. Instead she suggested Madhubala's name.

After a quiet spell in the early 1960s when she gave birth to her son Mohnish, Nutan was back in the studios

During her absence, Bimal Roy for his Parakh and Prem Patra casting her in the Nutan mould, a fact Sadhana herself corroborates. "Nutan was my idol," Sadhana has always

Recalling that they made a fine pair, her hit costar Dev Anand has said, "Nutan was one of the few actresses with whom one could have an intelligent conversation.

In 1963, Nutan had two diametrically different films released within a month of each other - Bimal Roy's somber Bandini (Nutan had to be persuaded to act in the film as she had quit acting after she had quit acting after marriage) and Dev Anand's jaunty crowd-pleaser *Tere Ghar* 

a quiet woman yoked to a hopeless love that drives her to murder and an eventual search for retribution still ranks among the best ever seen in Hindi films.

Award for Best Movie and she received her third Best Actress

Forbes India observed, "Nutan's genius lay in portraying a whole range of emotions without resorting to over-the-top histrionics."

Though Nutan acted in Shammi Kapoor extravaganzas like Laat Sahab clad in skirts and pants, the public seemed to prefer her in the sari-clad, selfsacrificing Saraswatichandra mould, secretly wiping away a tear and singing Main toh bhool chall babul ka desh.

This hit garba song was one of Nutan's few, full-fledged dance

But her life as an actor was not one without any controversies.

She once slapped actor Sanjeev Kumar - during the shooting of **Devi** (1970) - because he was making statements about their alleged relationship.

Talking about the incident, she said, "My slapping Sanjeev Kumar became a much-talked about incident.

"He made a very careless, irresponsible statement about us having an affair and that made me furious.

"I have never been linked with scandals and when he said what he did, I flew off the handle. I had to put him in his place.

"Afterwards I said what I had I cooled down and said, 'let's finish the love scene,' and we

Nutan, who was married at the time, felt that Sanjeev Kumar was intentionally defaming her to advance his career and that this fabrication was harming her

Soon after the slapping incident, there was a Bollywood party. Sanjeev was there and all the actors kissed his

This mobility made it look like there were many officers in the agency making the seem almost omnipresent across the whole





#### South Sudan Oil Output Increase To Ease Implementation Of Peace Deal

JUBA South Sudan (Xinhua) -- South Sudan's increased oil output, if used effectively, could spur economic recovery and ease implementation of the recently signed peace deal, experts said on Thursday.

The experts said the South Sudan's plan to raise oil production would help bring in much-needed funds to revive the country's shattered economy and run the activities of the expanded powersharing government.

Marial Awou Yol, head of the College of Social and Economic Studies at the University of Juba, said if the war-torn country can resume oil production in full speed, it can help relieve the cash shortage burden on the government and in turn stabilize the economy.

"Our economy is thirsty of resources, we can't import food now.

"We can't supply foreign reserves.

"We need production of oil to go as far as 350,000 (barrels per day).

"If we do that, we can be able to rejuvenate the economy and we will have enough resources to implement peace," the senior economist told Xinhua

Leaders of South Sudan's warring parties on last week signed a "final" power-sharing deal in Ethiopia, aimed at ending a civil war that has killed tens of thousands of people and displaced more than 4 million both internally and externally since

In the deal, the peace partners are expected to form a new transitional unity government in the next eight months.

South Sudan is the most oil-dependent nation in the world, with oil accounting for almost the totality of exports, and around 60 percent of its gross domestic product (GDP), according to the World

But after the young nation descended into civil war in late 2013, oil production declined amid soaring inflation and economic crunch.

The East African nation recently reopened oilfields that were suspended during the war and it hopes to reach its previous daily output of 350,000 barrels in 2019, petroleum minister Ezekiel Lol Gatkuoth announced recently.

Political analyst James Okuk said oil money is key for setting up and sustaining the new unity government because most foreign donors are still hesitant to support the latest agreement after a similar one was shattered in July 2016.

Okuk said though there are provisions for economic and institutional reforms in the peace agreement, the parties must this time show absolute commitment to implement the deal and stem out corruption in the power-sharing government.

"It (oil) will benefit the country and sustain the peace agreement because it was war that drained our resources and forced us into crisis," Okuk said. If this agreement is implemented in letter and spirit, it can fight corruption in the country."

Yol also agrees that corruption is a major issue that must be addressed during the three-year tenure of the power-sharing government.

"In the short history we have been a nation, we have been a corrupt nation and if we don't stem corruption out, it is not going to let us develop," Yol said.

"We should reform the institutions of the economy as well as the institutions of the government.

"This will encourage foreign investment in our country which we need most," he added.

## China-Sponsored Project to Ease Water Shortage in Kajiado County

NAIROBI (Xinhua) -Mercy Mungai credits her resilience and fortitude to the climatic shocks that often strike her village sandwiched between rolling hills that dot Kajiado County.

The middle-aged mother of four, who ekes out a living through subsistence farming, has been a victim of recurrent droughts that have worsened water scarcity and food insecurity in her hamlet

Mungai can now afford to put a smile on her face, thanks to the launch of a community water project in her locality by Kajiado county government and China Communications Construction Company (CCCC), which is implementing the Nairobi-Naivasha part of Kenya's Standard Gauge Railway (SGR) project

The lively small-scale farmer and her two young children attended the ground-breaking ceremony for Kimuka Community Water Aid Project on Thursday at the exit of the 4.5 km SGR Ngong tunnel, where water will be tapped for supply to nearby households.

"Having lived in this county for nearly two decades, I have endured the pain of trekking long distances to fetch water for domestic use

"This precious commodity has always eluded us due to frequent droughts," Mungai told Xinhua.

She is one of many who would benefit from the project an initiative of the CCCC and Kajiado county government to help ease water supply challenges in a region inhabited by nomads and small-holder farmers.

Guo Qing, deputy general manager of the CCCC Kenya SGR Project, said that water tanks with total storage capacity of 1,600 cubic meters will be constructed to help quench thirst among thousands of households in Kajiado County.

Clean water, found when the CCCC was building the tunnel, would be channeled to the tanks for community use

"We are proud to be part of the development of this particular water project that will enable more than 40,000 people in Kimuka area and the larger Kajiado County to access clean water," Guo

Mungal said the project will transform the locals' lives.

"I look forward to witnessing clean water gushing from the ever dry tap in my homestead," she said.

"My children will share in this

joy because they have also experienced the pain of acute water scarcity.

Community leaders in the expansive Kajiado County, which is part of Nairobi-Naivasha SGR corridor, praised the CCCC for initiating the project. the project as part of its corporate social responsibility

"As a community, we are proud to witness the launch of a project that will address critical water needs of people living in villages and fast growing urban centers," said Kajiado Governor Joseph Ole

He lauded the CCCC for financing livelihood projects in his county that include feeder roads, health centers and

Janet Teiya, Kajiado representative in the National Assembly, said the CCCC-funded water projects will have a profound impact on health, food security and productivity of local population.

"We are happy to have a water project that will greatly benefit vulnerable population groups like women, children

"This water can also be harnessed to promote irrigated farming in this region," Teiya

Kajiado youth who mainly eke a living from herding cattle or motorcycle transport business are optimistic the CCCC-funded water project would have a lasting impact on the community. on the community

Felix Kelembo, a 22-year-old motorcyclist, said that adequate supply of clean drinking water would stimulate agri-business in high potential sections of Kajiado County.

"The development of this region has been undermined

"Our farmers will be able to grow fresh produce that fetch better prices in urban centers," said Kelembo

Richard Seteki, a 22-year-old herder, said he plans to take up farming to expand his revenue base once there is adequate water supply in his family homestead.

"I am a witness to how access to clean drinking water can have a transformative effect on households living in semi-arid regions and therefore look forward to harnessing this commodity and embark on profitable farming ventures, Seteki said.





## Kenya among 12 Teams Lined Up Ahead Of Africa Men's Sevens Rugby Tourney!

NAIROBI (Xinhua) - Only 12 teams will compete in the Africa Men's Sevens rugby tournament, which will be held in October in Monastir, Tunisia.

Defending champion Kenya will use the tournament as part of their preparations for the rugby World Series, a 10-leg circuit, which will launch its campaign in Dubai in December

Abdelaziz Bougja, president of Rugby Africa, said he expects the teams to showcase their best talents and make the tournament entertaining.

"It is a tournament that unites values of rugby.

"We use the opportunity to organize youth tournaments, training sessions, and it is to the benefit of the entire rugby community," Bougja told Xinhua on Tuesday.

The Africa Men's Sevens tournament was renamed after the Rugby Africa's Sevens tournament and will be held on Oct. 13-14.

Atotal of 12 teams will compete However, there will be no South African side in the tournament

Kenya, Uganda, Zimbabwe, Madagascar, Zambia, Tunisia, Senegal, Morocco, Botswana, Senegal, Morocco, Botswana Ghana, Mauritius and Namibia

The tournaments will be played over two match days and the winner of "Africa Men's Sevens" will be the 2018 African Champion.

Meanwhile, former Kenya Sevens head coach Benjamin Ayimba believes his countryman Paul Murunga will emerge top in the recruitment process to take over the leadership of the national team after the contract of current coach Innocent Simiyu expires on October 31.

Simiyu has opted not to renew his contract and Kenya Rugby Union (KRU) has advertised the vacant position attracting 12 candidates, seven of which are foreign coaches.

Kenya has only appointed two foreign coaches before for the position, Englishman Mike Friday and South African Paul Treu.

The winning candidate will be named next week to start the team's preparation for both the Africa Men's Sevens tournament and the annual Safari 7s tournament.

"There is no other coach better

Paul (Murunga). He has achieved locally what no other coach has. I mean winning four out of six legs of the national circuit is not a mean feat and this is something that he has done repeatedly. Give him the job," said Ayimba.

"He has worked under me with the national team and club rugby and I know his work ethic, I know what he can do and I know

Murunga has also said he is ready to take up the challenge and guide Kenya in the World Series.

"I have worked as an assistant coach and I have also worked with the Kenya 15s team. I have learned more along the road and I think I am more than able to take over the job if given the chance,"

#### KIPCHOGE'S MARATHON MARK WILL LAST LONG, SAYS MAKAU

NAIROBI (Xinhua) - Retired marathoner Patrick Makau says it will take a long time and special talent to challenge Eliud Kipchoge's world record mark.

Kipchage attained in bilistering pace clinching the Berlin Marathon title in 2:01.39. His previous best of 2:03.05 had been attained in 2016 in winning the London marathon.

He made two attempts on the world record of compatriot

Dennis Kimetto in 2015 and 2017, but missed out owing to poor

However, that wait was worth as he shaved off one minute and 18 seconds off the world mark to write his name in the history book as the first man to run under two hours and two

"I watched the race for sure he made it look so easy unlike those before him who broke the record on the same course," said Makau, who reclaimed the world mark from Haile Gebreselassie with a time of 2:03.38 back in 2013.

"Kipchoge has put it too far. Anyone targeting that mark will know it will be a hard shot. It will take years before someone does it. I am happy for him because he has been persistent since 2012," added Makau.

Makau, 33, who has been forced to retire because kinsan, 35, who has been forced to fetre because of a tendon and knee injuries saw his mark broken by Wilson Kipsang in 2013 clocking an impressive 2:03.23, but again that went even further down with Kimetto arriving on the scene a year later to take the record to 2:02.57.

In all cases, the elite runners were breaking off seconds off the main mark, but for Kipchoge to slash off 78 seconds, it shows his position as the greatest ever to grace the race.

Kenya's Paul Tergat was the last man to take such a huge step when he broke Khalid Khannouchi's 2:05.38 record in Berlin in 2003 with a time of to 2:04:26.

It was also the largest single improvement on the marathon world record since Derek Clayton improved the mark by 2:23 in 1967 Meanwhile, celebrations continued in Kenya for the iconic

performance with calls for the Kenyan government to honor and reward their star athlete.

"The race was good and the weather was good. Everything was good. I want to say thanks to my pacemaker and my husband (Kenneth Kiplagat Tarus), he did the best job. I am very happy," she added.

Selection for the Kenyan World Marathon Championships team is not automatic. Whereas every athlete strives to produce their best run in top marathons, coa-ches review each performance.

Jemeli might still need another top performance between January and April to prove her fitness and secure a nod to join the team heading to Doha in 2019.

"More and more boxers are hanging the heavy amateur gloves for the lighter professional ones, the main reason being the financial implications involved," he remarked.

Wamburu said the rate at which Kenya is represented at the amateur level is discouraging for many of them in terms of remuneration - that is why the paid ranks provide an attractive option.

A number of boxers who have played in amateur boxing for years have made the crossover, although some of them have been past their sell-by date, at over 35 years.
