

## International Kenya Coast's 30th Anniversary The Anniversary Dinner of SKAL International on the Kenya Coast opened on a sombre note with all members and guests standing to observe a Minute's Silence in memory of the late Minister for Tourism and Wildlife, Karisa Maitha, who had died suddenly in Germany the previous evening.



Her work in oils, water, acryllic and tempera currently focus on the Eastern border areas of Kenya



## Whoops! From This Small Mis. calculation A Total Four Vehicles

Ended Up Seriously Damaged

Kachumbari recently stayed with a friend in Nairobi.

The residence was in an apartment block somewhere in Kilimani and faced a relatively busy road (by Mombasa

Most times of the day there was on average a vehicle going past every twenty seconds.

For Nairobi this is light traffic The average for Nairobi is traffic

During the few days he spent in the apartment he saw several accidents occur in the street adjacent to the place and all were what we would normally call stupid accidents.

Some of these happened whilst he was watching from the window of the apartment.

In the first accident, a fellow was approaching a turning next to the apartment block.

He was turning from the major road into a side road that led to the residential

The driver of the car that was to turn started to indicate to the right nearly fifty metres before he was due to turn.


The third car that had been in the speeding convoy then



## Generous Germans Give Hope And Support To Coast Disabled

It was an afternoon of utter joy for disabled children in the APDK (association for physically Disabled of Kenya) Rehabilitation Clinic, Port Reitz when they received a group of 70 German nationals from Jugen Weingarten and Polio Hife oberwolfach.

The two German organisations have for the last 15 years supported orthopaedic surgeries and rehabilitation of disabled children at the APDK Clinic.


