The air on the beachside is very salty and corrosive.

RESCUE AT SEA!

SPANISH NAVY SAVE 68 PEOPLE ADRIFT OFF SOMALIA

Spanish warship *ESPS Relámpago*, currently operating as part of the EU Naval Force - Operation ATALANTA, fighting piracy off the Somali Coast, has rescued 68 people after finding them adrift in a small boat off the Coast of Somalia.

The stricken vessel was first sighted from the air by a Japanese maritime patrol aircraft, and after hearing the report, *ESPS Relámpago*, launched her helicopter to locate the boat, while the warship proceeded at best speed to provide humanitarian assistance.

On arrival at the scene, marine engineers from the Spanish warship boarded the boat and carried out an inspection of the vessel's engine, which, due to it's very poor condition, failed to start despite several attempts by the crew.

As the stricken vessel was 100 nautical miles from the Somali coast, the decision was taken to tow the vessel to safety to the port of Boosasso, and at the same time provide some much needed food, water and medical assistance to the stranded passengers.

After the rescue, which lasted over 24 hours, all of the 68 people were safely disembarked at Boosasso port, in north Somalia.

Infrastructure Key To Port Success: Gichiri Nduia

Modern railways and well-developed highways and waterways are the critical components and lifeline of any Port, Managing Director Gichiri Nduia has said.

Delivering a paper, Enhancing Transport Connectivity by Investing in Port Infrastructure, Case Study on the Port of Mombasa in the 10th Intermodal Africa Conference and exhibition, Mr. Nduia said world over, efficiency and business success of any port depends on how well it is connected.

The two day event opened here at the International Conference centre (ICC), Durban South Africa.

It is the biggest annual Ports, shipping logistics exhibition and conference on the African continent.

The event is featuring 35 international speakers in global logistics and transport, and in attendance are over 500 senior executives from the world's leading ports, shippers, cargo owners and shipping lines.

Other participants are freight forwarders, logistics companies, terminal operators, railway operators and port-rail equipment service suppliers.

Also attending were the General Manager Engineering Services Eng. Joseph Atonga, General Manager Corporate Services, Mr. Justus Nyarandi and Chief Pilot Capt. William Ruto.

Over 60 international companies are showcasing their products and services at the prestigious event that was

officially opened by South Africa's acting Director of general transport Mr. Adam Seedat.

Mr. Nduia told the conference that while some ports were situated in crowded cities, some in long distances away from major towns and others in areas too remote, they all must be connected to their markets.

He added that approach to a port from the hinterland can be critical enough to spell doom or success since it determines turn-around and evacuation times of cargo that underline the proper functioning of any commercial port.

He said although inadequacies in port investments are commonly blamed for constraining maritime trade facilitation, in Mombasa it was lack of complementary infrastructural development that pose the biggest challenges to trade.

He noted that much as there could be limitations in quay or draft investments by the Authority, other incidental and peripheral investments could also improve port connectivity hence realizing fluidity into and out of the port.

The MD underscored the importance of Information communication Technology (ICT) application, threats posed by security insurgencies as well as the speed of turn-around of trains and trucks in port connectivity.

On the Port performance, the Managing Director noted that over the last twelve years, traffic through the Port of Mombasa had increased by 7.4 per cent per annum, rising from 9.13 million

tons in 2000 to 19.93 million tons in 2011.

He pointed out that the last five years has seen growth in throughput levels average 5.7 per cent which is more than the average growth rate of global maritime trade of 3.5 per cent.

"The growth was boosted by imports which grew at a rate of 8.1 per cent per annum while Exports on the other hand, grew at annual average rate of 4.5 per cent," added Mr. Nduia.

Between 2000 and 2011, he said, Container traffic grew by 11.6 per cent rising from 237,000 TEUs to 771,000 TEUs between the respective years.

The MD also talked of the ongoing Port Infrastructure Development including construction of the 240 m quay length berth 19 scheduled for completion in February 2013.

The associated stacking yard is approximately 15 acres and is expected to have throughput capacity of 200,000 TEUs annually.

He said construction of the 1.2 million TEU annual capacity second container terminal on a 100 hectares reclaimed land, west of Kipevu is ongoing.

The new container terminal will have three berths that measure 230, 320 and 350 metres.

Dredging will be carried out to depths of -15 metres for the main quay length of 670 metres, -12m for quay length of 230 metres, -11 metres for quay length of 210 metres and -4.5 metres for quay length of 83 metres.

The construction started on 1 March 2012 and completion is expected in March 2016.

Mr. Nduia told the participants that a suitable site has been identified within the harbor to relocate the Kipevu oil Terminal which is currently encroached by other cargo handling facilities.

He disclosed that work on the new facility will also house installations for handling some refined products will start in the course of the year.

He said KPA was currently implementing an Integrated Security System to safeguard the Port from intrusion and raise security standards.

The systems include, among others, main Security Center and Security Backup Center, CCTV system, Taut barbed wire Perimeter Intrusion Detection (PIDS) fence, 4.6 km long and 2 m high, 17 Detector grid barriers for protection of water channels, access Control System X-ray and metal detector equipment at entrances and Alarm controller systems

On other planned port developments, the Managing Directors noted that development of Free Port facilities on 3,000 acres of

land at Dongo Kundu area through public private partnership arrangements was still in course.

He said the design of the Road Bypass to link the project area

and Mombasa - Lungu Nairobi Highway is in the construction is expected to start next year.

The Road Bypass is the New Container Terminal

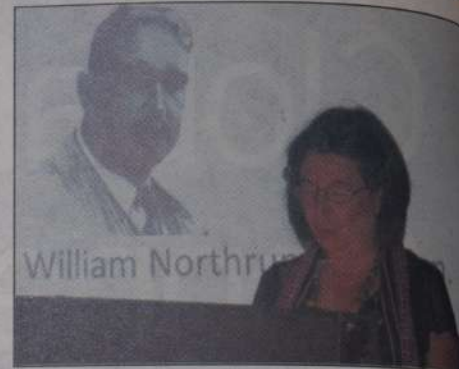

U17 Team Back Home After Impressive Fourth Position

The Kenya U17 contingent of 16 players and three officials who travelled to Pretoria for the COPA Coca-Cola inter-country tournament arrived back home on Saturday, after a fairly successful tournament that saw the team finish a decent fourth out of fourteen countries.

The team departed OR Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg at exactly 1.15pm Kenyan time for the flight and they touched down at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) nearly four hours later.

"We didn't win the tournament as we planned to but we are

home with our heads held up high because we did our best given the circumstances," said Coach Arthur Apiyo who expressed his desire to continue working with the players and the current U17 coach David Ouma.

Kenya registered laudable results during the 12-day international camp at St. Alban's College in Pretoria in spite of being only one among other three teams who were not in camp prior to the tournament.

They convincingly beat Uganda, shrugged off the challenge of Tanzania and also indexed in a comfortable 1-0 win over Central and West Africa (CEWA) combined team.

Kenya also managed draws against eventual champions Zambia and continental heavyweights Nigeria.

Even the narrow 1-0 losses against Mozambique who already departed for their U17 duties, Malawi and Zimbabwe could have been wins with some luck on the Kenyan side.

"Just like fine wine, every good thing takes time," said Arthur who had only two days to train the team.

"The talent is there, but we just need to refine it going forward," he added.

The performance of the Kenyan team didn't escape the eyes of talent scouts at the tournament.

Two Kenyan players, Eugene Moses Mukangula and Omar Mwinyi, were keenly followed by scouts from South Africa Premier League side Supersport United while defender Sadam Abdulahi and midfielder anchorman and team captain Haron Nyakha made it to the COPA All-Star team.

"It's been a good experience for us and we've picked a lot from the competition which we will put to good use back home," said Ramadhan Abdulmalik who shrugged off a nagging injury to feature for Kenya.

"This was a step in the right direction for all the players. But we have reached the limit yet; the journey has just began," said Castro Mwaura who was among the goal scorers for the Kenyan team.

The only thing that is not clear is what happens with the team going forward. Kenya U17 was due to play Tanzania on September 9th but the match has since been cancelled.

"We are ready to for any duty when called upon. From what I have seen, there's little doubt that we can indeed be the future of Kenyan football," said diminutive right full-back Kevin Otieno.

Kenya To Host 'Shuttle Time'

BY BEN OCHIENG NAIROBI (Kinuhua) — Kenya has been selected among four other countries by the Badminton World Federation (BWF) to host a pilot program dubbed 'Shuttle Time'.

The program aims to help teachers and coaches develop skills for the game, knowledge and confidence to plan and deliver safe and fun badminton lessons to children and the youth.

Shuttle Time is an innovative self-study training program that helps teachers and coaches learn how to teach badminton to children and youth through the usage of teachers' manuals, lesson plans and instructional video clips.

Speaking in Nairobi on Monday during the launch BWF Development Manager, Ian Wright said the idea is about training teachers about being able to deliver on some courses and not to make them full time coaches.

"The program is about training trainers who will in turn train teachers to give enough information to deliver the experience to school going children and the youth so as to broaden the scope of the game globally."

Describing badminton as a low impact sport for school children, Wright said the sport is a global game that is acceptable to all and which can be performed right through the ages for a healthy lifestyle.

"Kenya has been chosen

because of its long standing membership in the BWF and due to its existing facilities and its potential to become the regional project for East Africa."

He said badminton is represented in Africa and local federations do not have the resources to deliver the program on their own hence the world body's intervention to see to its spread.

Kenya's Minister for Sports Paul Otuma said badminton has not undergone much progress locally and welcomed BWF's intervention which he termed as timely.

"That the program will instinctively reach out to the public is in line with Kenya's policy of emphasizing on sports development as opposed to performance," Otuma said.

"Many non-sports people are only interested in performance of athletes without knowing how they get there and with this program, those queries will be addressed."

He said Shuttle Time is bound to be a great success because one of the resources needed to see to its triumph, the youth, is already in great abundance.

In June 2011, Kenya hosted the International Badminton Championships in Nairobi in which over 20 countries participated.

Badminton is a racquet sport played by either two opposing players (singles) or two opposing pairs (doubles) who take positions on opposite halves of a rectangular court that is divided

by a net.

Players score points by striking a shuttlecock with their racket so that it passes over the net and lands in their opponents' half of the court.

A rally ends once the shuttlecock has struck the floor.
