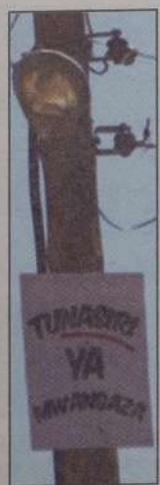

Made from composite materials, the Boeing 787 Dreamliner is the first mid-size airplane capable of flying long-range routes.

Qatar Airways' customers will experience cabin environment improvements such as improved lighting, bigger windows, larger overhead bins, lower cabin altitude and enhanced ventilation systems, among other features.

Qatar Airways' new 787s feature a total of 254 seats in a two-class configuration of 22 in Business Class and 232 in Economy.

With a 1-2-1 configuration in Business Class, the layout features two less seats than competitors on conventional wide body aircraft, more typical of a First Class cabin where each passenger is assured of direct aisle access. The seats have been designed exclusively for Qatar Airways.

The seat offers considerable personal space - almost double than existing business cabins - allowing passengers to sit back and relax in a 22-inch wide armchair that converts at a touch of a button into different cradle positions before reaching an extremely generous 80-inch long, 30-inch wide flat bed offering exceptional legroom.

Armrests can be fully adjusted to complement different body positions while dining, reading, working or resting. 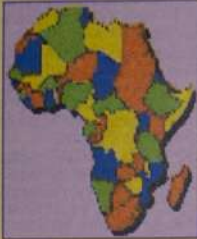

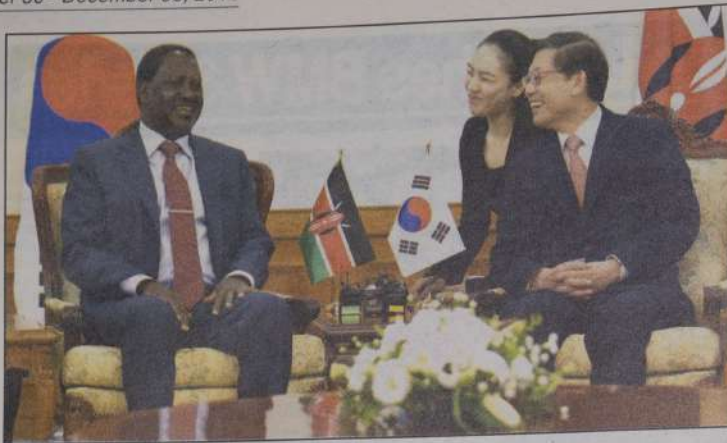

Kenya Seeking Closer Ties With Both Malaysia and South Korea

NAIROBI (Xinhua) -- Prime Minister Raila Odinga has called for collaboration between Kenya and east Asian nations that will help redefine and rebrand the country's global image while repositioning Kenya's products and services internationally, reports Chris Mgidu.

Raila Odinga made the remarks in Malaysia, according to a statement from his office after he returned to the country on Thursday after a week-long official visits to Malaysia and

South Korea. The PM said history has shown that from time to time, nations need to take hard, and sometimes lonely decisions in order to attain their development goals.

This, he said, is what Asian nations, led by former Prime Minister Dr. Mahathir Mohamed did to achieve tremendous political and economic transformation over the last few decades.

"The 'Asian Miracle' compelled a fundamental change in the world economic order. A small club of industrialized nations can no longer dictate the future of global economy. It is the G-20,

no longer the G-7 that is the most influential forum of global leaders,".

Odinga called for collaboration in area of information technology with particular focus on development of the proposed Konza technology and innovation city.

"We are keen on a collaboration that will accelerate the development of creative industries in Kenya.

"And we are looking for ties that will create and lift Kenyan entrepreneurs while building focus and confidence in our Vision 2030," Odinga said.

He said Kenya's Vision 2030 borrows heavily from Malaysia's Vision 2020.

He expressed hope that in about a decade, Kenya will be where Malaysia is today and even catch up.

Odinga regretted that despite very close ties between Asia and Africa and Malaysia and Kenya in the earlier decades of independence, those ties have weakened over time, and left Kenya and Africa behind.

"I hardly see any tourists from Malaysia in Kenya. I do not see many students from Malaysia. Malaysian companies are not nearly as active in Africa as I wish them to be," the PM said.

He called on the countries of ASEAN and its counterpart, East Africa Community (EAC) to convene a meeting of the Heads of State and Government, to establish a framework for an economic partnership.

A Medical and Eye check-up camp was held at Muslim Luhar Wadha Jamat Hall on 25th November 2012.

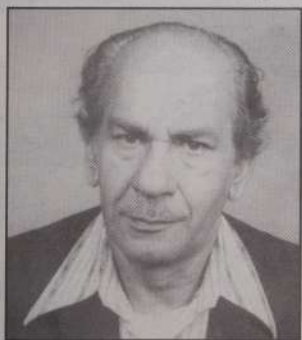

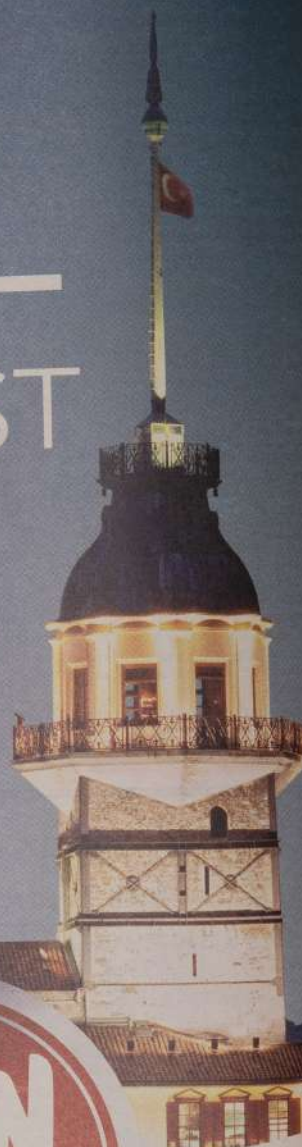

Deloitte Creates Agricultural Division

Consulting firm, Deloitte East Africa, has created a new agri-business division, to help foreign multinationals and local small and medium enterprises to engage in marketing of the agricultural produce, John Kiarie, a Partner with Deloitte Kenya Consulting announced in Nairobi today.

Mr Kiarie said they are working with some 21 multinational companies, including Nestle, Unilever, Unga, Proctor and Gamble, among others to increase their sourcing of locally produced raw material to a threshold of about 60 per cent.

"We are developing capacities for agricultural projects both for the government and the private sector, to ensure a sustainable supply chain for multinational companies and other small and medium enterprises," Mr Kiarie said during a breakfast session

to announce the outcome of the Value Chain and Matching Grant Fund, financed by the ministry of industrialization.

The new division has been created after the successful implementation of the pilot project to improve the quality of agricultural produce and create links to international markets for the Kenyan produce.

The Value Chain project was targeted at the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises. Deloitte Consultants helped to create management boards to promote the marketing of leather, pyrethrum, coffee and cotton across the world, leading to a marked growth to participating firms.

The volume and quality of agricultural produced over the seven year period through the project implementation led to a 48 per cent increase in production and a 50 per cent growth in revenue for the small and

medium sized companies involved.

Ministry of Industrialization Permanent Secretary Dr Karanja Kibicho, whose ministry commissioned the project, said the government would enforce a requirement of 70 percent local materials for all government contractors to ensure the country benefits from the ongoing infrastructure investments.

This means contractors supplying staff uniforms to any government agency, the police and the military would be required to use at least 70 percent of locally available materials in the production of goods.

Dr Anthony Getambu,

Deloitte's Value Chain Specialist, said during the project implementation, Coffee sales were enhanced and links created with coffee millers and roasters worldwide to market the produce.

Kenyan coffee has now been graded internationally, which means it would now fetch higher than the international price at the various coffee auction.

The project team has also called for the full liberalization of the pyrethrum sector to save it from its near collapse.

The cooperatives sector in Kenya have evolved into a single stop shop, owning their own coffee roasting and milling plants to ease the marketing of the final project.

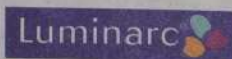

Sunday, 25th November dawned nice and clear upon one of the most keenly contested competitions in the golfing calendar at the Coast, the annual Coast Ladies Interclub Challenge Competition.

It is a competition that pits one team against others, drawn from the ladies sections of the Coast based golf clubs, originally starting as a match play between Mombasa Golf Club and Nyali Golf Club, subsequently widened to cover Malindi and later joined by the new comer on the golfing scene, Leisure Golf Club.

Unlike a normal golf competition where a player basically plays against a course, trying to beat the course better than anyone else and in the

process to come tops in the entire field, without there being an opponent in the real sense of the term, in match plays, there is definitely an opponent whom you wish to vanquish and conquer.

It is the clear goal of beating a specific opponent that brings the heightened sense of rivalry in match play competitions that is not felt in golf competitions played week after week on the usual individual stroke play formats.

This sense of rivalry and the desire to defeat one's opponent is present in all match play competitions, be it the humble four ball better ball played amongst friends for small beer, the reward quite literally being a round of beer at the end of a round of golf or on the much larger canvas with matches watched by millions of riveted fans when continents clash against each other, the most famous being the contest for the Ryder Cup which brings entire Europe against the mighty USA.

This is the spirit in which the ladies of the Coast clubs fight out for the coveted Interclub Championship Trophy, albeit a small and modest copper statue of a lady golfer in full flow of her swing.

But then it is not so much the Trophy itself but the roll of honour inscribed on the Trophy that the ladies turn up so determinedly to fight for.

The fact that Mombasa golf Club has been claiming that honour, year in year out for the last six years running must have given a greater impetus to their rivals to try and wrench the Trophy away from Mombasa and which Nyali succeeded in doing this year.

And the fact that they did it on Mombasa's home course must have made the revenge taste sweeter!

It is a course that even the

regulars find daunting, made more difficult with the conditions at present, the fairways resembling more the rough fringes of smooth fairways on a normal course.

The Coast clubs ladies section have varying strength and are not always able to raise the same number of teams to play a classic match play.

The ladies have therefore adopted a slightly modified format to suit the circumstances.

All participating clubs enter a minimum of six players to make three pairs to play Greensomes off stableford points and the club with the highest combined total of stableford point is the winner.

In the event there are more than six players from a club, the best of three scores are taken into account.

It turned out to be a three way battle, among Mombasa, Nyali and Leisure, Malindi not being able to participate this year.

Each of the clubs entered four pairs.

The winning Nyali team was headed by the Lady Captain Pia Swatton paired with the in form Christine Okitch and the duo rose well to the occasion, bringing a pair score of 35 stableford points which was the highest individual pair score.

The win did not come easy, only 3 points separated the team of Nyali with 91 points from the defending champions Mombasa who fell short with their 88 points.

Mombasa had the consolation of bagging two out of the three prizes for best individual pair scores.

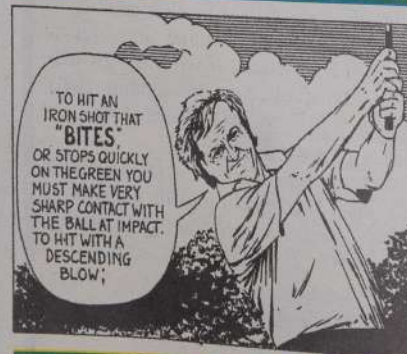
