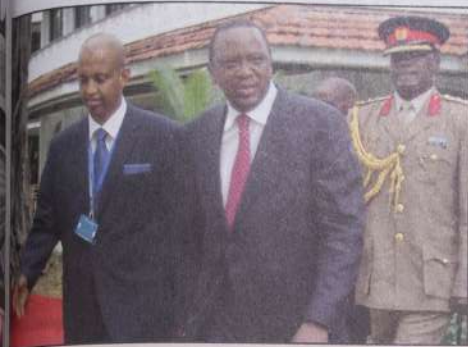

Promote Kora National Park as 'A Tourist Destination'

Investive Lagat TANA (Xinhua) -- Kenya's largest national park is a prized destination for local and foreign tourists keen to sample the attractions as the government develops the park's infrastructure to achieve this goal.

Officials reveal that the development of critical infrastructure including roads, power and telecommunications, has invited private investors to put accommodation facilities at Kora national park.

The national park has not been fully utilized as a prime tourist destination.

There is light at the end of the tunnel with the tarmacking of the Lamu-Kyuso road and development of the Lamu Port South Sudan and Ethiopia Transport Corridor (LAPSSET).

When these projects are completed, Kora will be the new destination for visitors," said Kenya Wildlife Service director William Orero.

He spoke at Kora National Park during the 24th anniversary of the death of British conservationist George Adamson.

Located in Tana River County on the Kenyan Coast, Kora National Park was gazetted in 1989 and occupies an extensive grass mass estimated at 1,789 square kilometers.

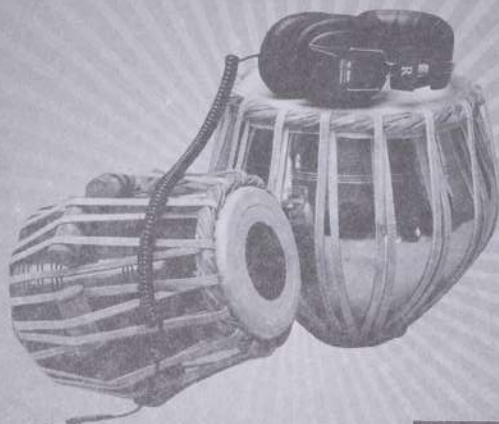
