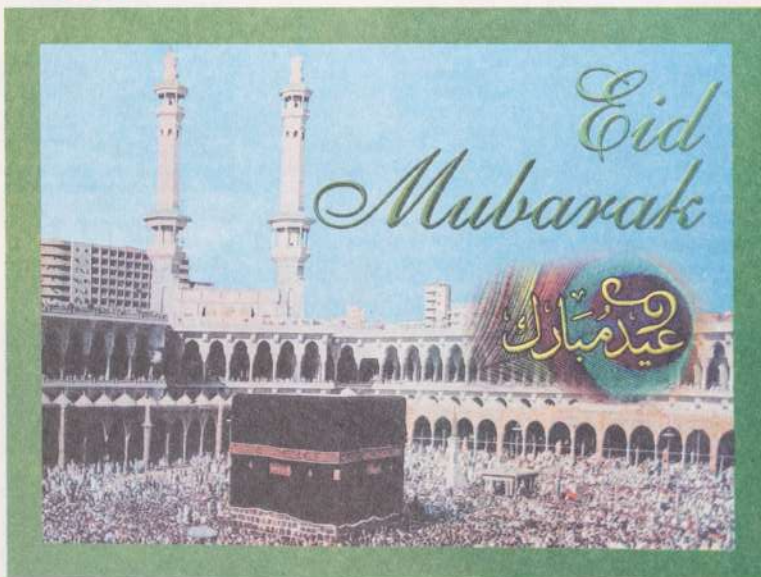

Buying new outfits and redecorating homes is a near tradition symbolizing purification from sins and the exhibition of

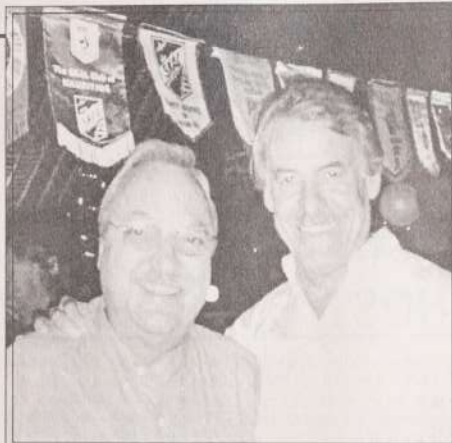

Nach Mitternacht wird eine weitere Mahlzeit Daku eingenommen, meistens Curry mit Reis, Sauermilch und eine Süßspeise.

Zwischen Futari und Daku

beten die Frauen zu Hause und lesen im Koran, oder sie wandern in ihren schwarzen Umhängen, genannt Buibui, durch die Straßen, besuchen Freundinnen und tauschen mit ihren Essen und kleine Geschenke aus; dieser Brauch heißt Bembe.

Nach Daku steht einem wohlverdienten Schlaf nichts mehr im Weg bis um 5 Uhr früh, wenn es Zeit ist für das Morgengebet und ein neuer Fastentag beginnt.

Der Islam verlangt, dass mit dem Fasten auch die höchsten ethischen Grundsätze eingehalten werden.

Enthaltsamkeit bedeutet Verzicht auf Nahrung, Wasser, Tabak und Sex von Sonnenaufgang bis Sonnenuntergang.

Während des Fastenmonats gibt mangroßzügig Almosen an die Armen.

Viele wohlhabende Leute laden auch Bedürftige ein, an

ihrem Abendessen teilzunehmen.

In Mombasa ist der Fastenmonat besonders merkbar in der großen Digostraße zur Digostraße, in der Gemüsemärkte.

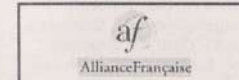

"We are working hard to make sure Coast soccer regain its lost past football glory," said the KFF Coast soccer boss.

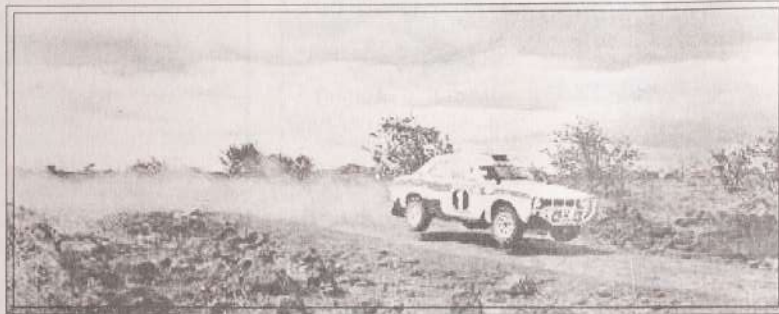
