admiration, UNESCO will continue to offer support" she concluded.

In Memory of her visit she presented copies of an album and books that contains the main publication of the list of Intangible cultural heritage in need of urgent safeguarding that includes the Mijikenda traditions to the senior most Kaya elder Daniel Begarero.

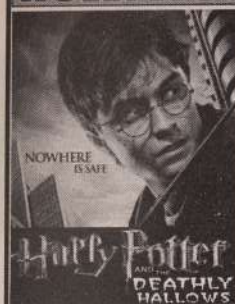

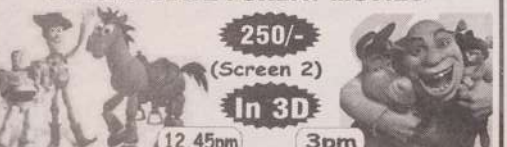

Imran Khan and Deepika Padukone are the lead pair in this romantic comedy that also stars Sharmila Tagore and Shahana Goswami.

Couples living together before marriage is very much the in-thing in India, yet traditionalists will refuse to accept it.

We begin with two kids, Abhay and Aaliya who are best buddies from the age of four.

As they turn into teenagers, Abhay realizes that Aaliya is the one, and only one, for him.

He of course wants to spend the rest of their lives together, happily ever after.

Aaliya does love him, but she has ambition and wants to be big actress, no matter what the cost.

Like all couples in love, they also have their differences, despite their feelings for each other.

Sometimes those differences are resolved, other times they are swept under the carpet, where the 'dirt' continues to collect.

Until one day, the pile is too big to go unnoticed.

Ethan Mascarenhas has his shadow by his side in the form of

*Guzaarish* has received some fabulous reviews from Indian critics including Taran Adarsh, Nikhat Khazmi (*Times of India*) and Santabanta.com.

Critic Subhash K Jha goes on to say that "...no film in living memory has brought out the sheer blessing of being alive with such spirit and glory".

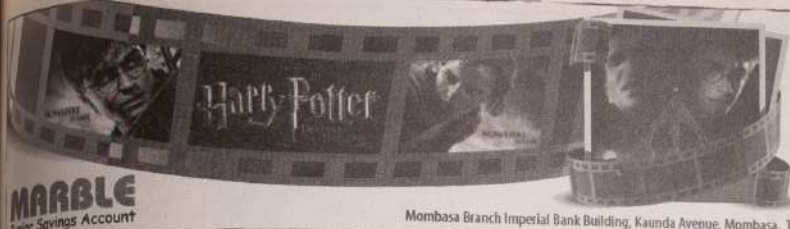

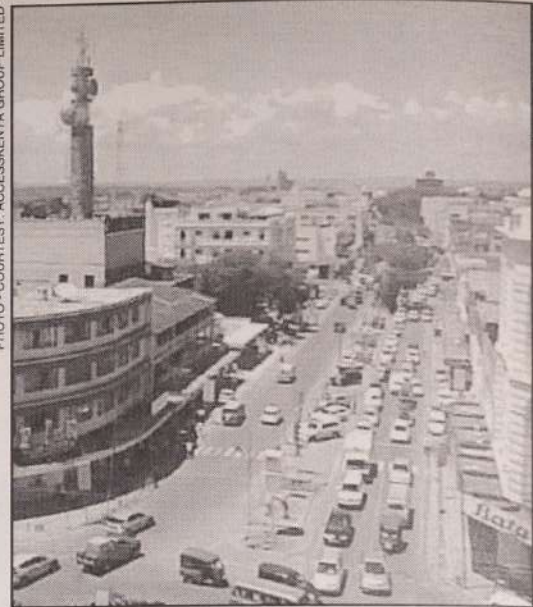

Why do certain religions insist on practicing the faith at ear splitting levels even in residential areas where peace and quiet should prevail?

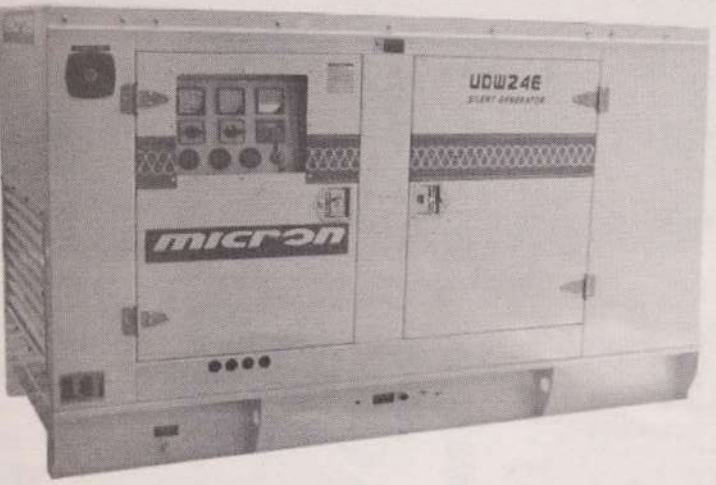
I have written about this many times over the years despite there now being a law passed by NEMA regarding noise pollution, very little enforcement of it is apparent.

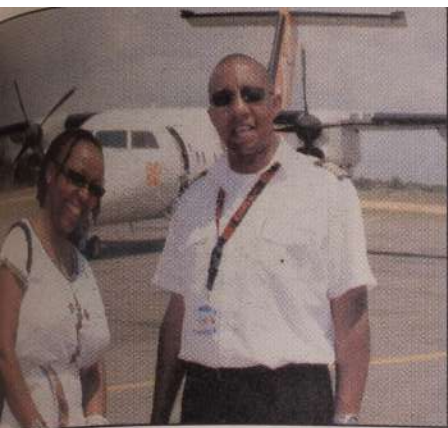

# Short Cuts and Exiting Around All That Festive Season Traffic

We have always been looking at ways of getting around the island in the event of frustration or should there be a major road accident or when parts of the main Nairobi or other road collapses.

The usual suspects are clear. From the North Coast one could go all the way back to Kilifi and then use the Kaloleni to Mazaras road to get into town.

The shorter but more probably rougher section is to go through Nguu Tatu to Ribe or Rabai and then on to Mazaras.

From the South Coast the main option is to get all the way to Kinango and then either come to Mazaras, Mariakani or Samburu depending on which direction one is headed.

Kachumbari recently decided to take a look at all these roads after having been asked by many buddies in Nairobi about how to get to their favorite Christmas coast destinations.

For those who will be heading to the South Coast as it currently stands the best bet is to stick out the long and hot route and go via the ferry.

The roads between Samburu, Mariakani, Mazaras and the South Coast need quite a bit of work to be done to them.

The recent rains have left some of the sections deeply rutted and some areas fairly rough.

However, all it would take is a week's worth of work with several graders and bulldozers to create an easily motorable road from any of the three entry points.

The road to Kwale from Kinango also needs a little bit of dressing up.

For the immediate future there is need to give a lot more attention to the Mazaras Kwale road as this one will serve as a multiple option route.

It will open up an option for heavy goods vehicles that would like to take material to the South Coast from the western side of the island and mainland especially as the queues begin to grow towards the festive season and as the tourist season also begins to get to its full flow.

It would also help to reduce the

to be tarmacked.

This will have the same impact as the upgrading of the Kinango Mazaras road.

It will divert a lot of traffic from the Island that now uses and clogs up the Nyali bridge area for no reason except that it is the better road.

This will also divert upcountry traffic as well as tourist traffic that is headed for North Coast, Watamu or Kilifi.

There is currently some upgrading and repair work taking place in the section from Mazaras to Kaloleni but the pace is so snail like that I am convinced and could also put my money on the table that it is being done by a local contractor.

Let us get real and go to Nairobi to see what is possible with professionalism and dedication.

The Chinese are showing it all over the place. The routes through Nguu Tatu would need grading for now to make suitable alternatives but again.

In the long term, there is need for as second crossing to the North Coast from the West Mainland and that could be done easily from the Jomvu area making use of the island present in the creek to ensure that there is minimum disturbance of the ecosystem that exists on the mangrove plantations that are prolific in that area.

As we approach the festive season, it is important for the Town Fathers and the Rural, Urban and national Roads Authorities to get their act together and make a concerted effort to do some medium term work that will make travel easy for those who will be going from their normal abodes to other parts of the country.

We have looked at the Coast as that is where we live but the same applies across the whole country.

If we make our roads better then the likelihood of silly accident will diminish and we can travel in the knowledge that our chances of reaching our destinations safely will have been enhanced.

As Kachumbari says, good planning and efficient execution is the panacea for success.

volume of upcountry traffic that has to transit through Mombasa when it really doesn't have to.

In a recent workshop, the Minister for Transport indicated that there would be two projects to improve access to the South Coast.

The first and major one would be the construction of a causeway and bridge combination from a point in Miritini close to the old explosives jetty linking that point to an area close to Dongo Kundu.

This has been talked about for over thirty years and we hope that this time round the talk will end and action will start - over to you Minister Amos.

The second project and one we believe should be tackled immediately is to upgrade the road from Mazaras to Kinango with a spur heading to Dongo Kundu.

This will start the shift of traffic to that route even before the planned causeway is put together.

It will also spur developments in the southern hinterland of Mazaras that will begin to ease pressure from the West mainland.

As for the North Coast, the most obvious short term investment required is that the road from Kilifi to Kaloleni needs

His three over par outward nine of 39 strokes was marred by only one double bogey, on par four 4th resulting in 1 point.

This deficit was compensated by a two club birdie on the 3rd yielding 3 points and with 3 points resulting from pars on stroking holes 6th, 7th and 9th, the 12 handicapper set the stage for something special, with 21 points on the 1st nine.

Another nine, also of three over par 38, followed the 1st

nine. A bogey on par five 11th was the only other hole on the card, apart from the 4th, with 1 point.

This was offset by a par on the stroking hole 10th and pars on the remaining stroking holes 14th, 16th and 18th gave Dinesh the additional 3 points, to equalise with 1st nine total of 21 points, to get to the grand total of 42 points and the overall Mombasa Continental Resort Golf Day Prize.

The next best score in the field was 4 points lower, a 38 returned by Nicholas Soares who however falls into the Junior class and had to be content with the Best Junior prize.

Five points separated Dinesh from the next in the men's category, 37 carded by two men, Peter Driest and Qamar Somji.

Both of them came up with an identical breakdown of 16 and 21 points requiring a further scrutiny to decide the winner man.

With a par on the double stroking 15th yielding 4 points, the 25 handicapper Peter managed to beat the steadier 10 handicapper Qamar for the Men's Winner prize.

Qamar in the second place was followed by Mumo Thyaka on 36 but who also needed to fight off the challenge from Anthony Warui and John Waigwa.

Mumo's excellent countback of 23 points coming off 6 pars, of which 10th, 11th, 14th and 18th producing 3 points each and a two club birdie on 18th adding 4 more

points, easily prevailed over the others.

Mzee Anthony however secured for himself the Best Senior prize.

Also on 36 was Edward Kiema, a Junior who followed Nicholas into the Runner up Junior prize.

One point behind these winners, on 35, stood Pia Swatton who emerged the Lady Winner.

Following Pia closely on 34 points were Dianah Muyao and the Lady Captain Jane Mburu, both with identical breakdown of 16 and 18 but Dianah was able to beat Jane on the countback.

Jane having started well on the back nine with 3 points each on first three holes, made a couple of bogeys and a bogey on the remaining holes which cut into her early score of 9 points, whereas Dianah went on steadily, picking up 12 points on the last six holes.


D N Njoka won the Guest prize while Ann Ndegwa claimed the "Staff" prize.

The evening ended with a warm applause for Ann and Duncan Ndegwa and the entire team of Mombasa Continental Resort in appreciation for the competition, the hand outs for the golfers, the running lunch, tea, delicious bitings after the prize giving and the generous offers of discounts for Nyali members for some of the forthcoming events of the festive season at the Resort.
