





## KWALE DISTRICT EYE CENTRE NEEDS YOUR SUPPORT

BLINDNESS IN Kenya is ten times more common than plindness in the Western World.

One person in every hundred is blind (as defined by the World Health Organisation of <3/60 in the better eye).

This is due in part to a lower standard of living conditions and different diseases, but mostly the divide is due to lack of affordable, accessible eye

The Kwale District Eye Centre as been established to over-ome this difficulty and is orking to bring affordable eye are to the people of the South oast.

In the Developing World 80 per cent of blind people suffer from conditions which are avoidable.

Their disease could either have been prevented by early detection and treatment, or it could be corrected surgically.

The treatment and cure is by

surgery.

The Kwale District Eye Centre corrects cataract by removal of the cataractous lens and insertion of a plastic lens which remains in the eye.

This method is now consider-

ed the most successful world wide.

Kwale District is an area of 8,608 square km on the Southern Coast.

It is largely rural and travel off the few main roads is difficult.

The Kwale District Eye Centre, a Self Help Project, is located 11 km South of Mombasa at Magandia just off the main road.

The Centre opened in October 1993 and consisted of a single room and a small reception area on a one acre plot

This single room catered as both an eye clinic for the out-patients and as a theatre for

in the first year, 650 eye patients were treated and 50 operations carried out.

The initial staff were an Ophthalmologist, an Ophthalmic Technician, a cleaner and three 'askaris'.

#### MODERN **OPERATING** THEATRE

In 1994 the existing building was extended to include a modern operating theatre and sterilising room, office, dehumidified store and wash up area.

Running well water is now

This facility is of great need since most of the surgical patients are elderly and suffering from very poor sight.

Kwale District Eye Centre is a charitable project. Patients pay a nominal fee only.

For example, the cost of a consultation is only Kshs. 40/-.
