

TUMEPIGA HATUA KUBWA YA MAENDELEO

KWA ujumla nchi yetu ya Kenya ilipiga hatua kubwa ya maendeleo katika mwaka huu wa 1983 kutoka ukumbi wa kisasa pamoja na mambu mengine yanayohusiana na michezo kwani klubu yetu ya AFC Leopards pamoja na timu ya taifa ya Harambee Stars na wanariadha walutwala uwania we michezo katika Afrika Mashariki na Kati.

Tukizungumza juu ya michezo, haturi budi kurudi nyuma hadi mwezi wa Januari ambapo timu zetu mbili za AFC Leopards pamoja na Gor Mahia zilipowakilisha nchi yetu katika mapambano ya kung'ang'an komba la klubu bingwa za Afrika mashariki na Kati.

Mapambano hayo yanifanyika huko kisiwani Unguja, yaani Zanzibar na kila timu iliyofikirika ilikuwa na nia kubwa ya kusimamishi utawala wa timu zetu za Kenya katika mashindano haya. Lakini wapi! Wanagozi wetu walioondoka hapa kwa kuhifadhi bendera yetu, hawakutishwa na vitisho vyoyote vya nchini.

Hakikuwa ajabu yoyote wakati wanasoza wa AFC Leopards walipowaga kurudi na kombe hilo kwa mara ya tatu mfululizo na kilibakisha hapa nchini masha. Pongezi zisizo na kifani zastahili kuwaenda vijana hao wa AFC Leopards kwa kutahamisha mataifa mengine kwamba Kenya ndiko kwene ujuzi wa kulisuka kabumbla la hali ya juu katika Mashariki ya bara, hili letu la Afrika.

Mambo mengi ya maendeleo pamoja na michango ya Harambee ya lidenledeka katika mieuza ya Januari hadi mwezi wa Agosti ambapo Wakanya wote walishuhudia sherehe za kutawaza kwa ukumbusho wa mwaka watano toka Rais Daniel arap Moi alipokililia usukani wa kirtawala kuliogozta taifa letu la Kenya.

Rais Moi alishikilia hatamu hizmo mnemo mwezi wa Agosti wakati Mwanza wa taifa hili, Hayati Mzee Jomo Kenyatta aliopoaga dunia hapo mwaka 1978 mnemo mwezi Agosti tarehe 22 alipouka mapumzikiwa hapa Mombasa.

Katika mieuza yote hiyo, Mtukufu Rais Moi alidenleka na mawaidha yake ya kuwatada akemya wajijumilishi pamoja katika kujengwa nchi yetu. Na akazidi kusisitiza maongozi yake ya filosofia NYAYO ambayo yanakariki zaidi juu ya umoja upendo wa wananchi wote pamoja na kudhumisha amani kote nchini.

Wananchi walipewa fursa na Mtukufu Rais Moi wa kuwachagua viongozi ambao watakuwa tayarai kumsaidia kuendesha Serkali. Rais alilitisha uchaguzi huo mwaka mmoja kabila ya wakati wake kutohaka na malimkizi kuwa baadhi ya viongozi wa hili juu hawakawa wa amanuina kwa Rais Moi pamoja na Serkali.

Wananchi walipewa na mwezi hiyo na wakawea kutumia haki walizopewa kwa kupiga kura mnemo September 26, 1983 na kote nchini viongozi yaani Wabunge na Midwives wakachaguliwa kwa kura za wananchi Kenya ikizidi kuufahamisha Ulimwengu kwamba inazingatia kiuamiliu demokrasia.

Viongozi kadhi kutohaka Bara la Afrika pamoja na nichinyingine za Ulimwengu walitembelea Kenya katika mieuza mbali mbali na kufanya namzungumzo na Rais Moi pamoja na viongozi wa Serkali;

mazungumzo ambayo ni ya manufaa kwa wananchi wote wa Kenya.

Mnamo mwezi wa **Novemba**, tulikuwa nma furaha ya kupita kiasi wakati viongozi wa mataifa matatu ya Afrika Mashariki na Kati, Marais Moi, Nyerere na Obote walipokutana huko Arusha nchini Tanzania na kuafikiana kurudisha uhustiano mwema baina ya mataifa haya ambayo yanikilishi ndugu aliyezalisha "tumbo moja" hapo awali.

Mukutano huo wa Harambee Stars ulipatikanwa mwezi wa **Novemba** ambapo Kenya Ndiyo Ilyosimamia mashindano haya yanifanyauata mafaita tisa yak-wemo, Zimbabwe, Malawi, Tanzania Mainland, Zanzibar, Somalia, Uganda, Ethiopia, Sudan na wenyeji wa Harambee Stars.

Mwezi wa **Desemba** ndio uliokuwa na kilele cha furaha ya Wakanya kwani ndipo wakati tulipokumbuka na kusherekeeria miaka 20 toka tujikimbwe kutohaka na minyororo ya wakoloni.

LOOKING AT A VERY GOOD CHRISTMAS!

INDICATIONS are that it is going to be a Very Merry Christmas and New Year at the Coast, for beach hotels have been working flat out to make this festive season the best ever, writes NETA PEAL.

Among the visitors from home and overseas will be many 'repeat' guests.

The arrival of Papa Christmas at the Coast, although dressed in the traddy pillar-box red suit and sporting a long white beard, is not so traditional - for he has no chimney pots to squeeze down!

So he sometimes arrives by boat, 'mini' moke, pony cart, parachute or camel bearing sacks laden with presents for young guests.

Entertaining at the coast over the festive season will be the famous African Heritage band playing 'black' African music including jazz.

The band recently returned from a successful tour of Mauritius where it added to its collection of traditional musical instruments.

Their tour of the Kenya coast includes performances at *Jadi* Beach Hotel on December 20 and 21.

At beach hotels there will be carols around illuminated Christmas Trees, lively entertainments programmes, all the traditional Christmas fare, and lots of other mouth-watering cuisine to enjoy.

Helping draw up the Christmas menus at *Nyali Beach Hotel* has been Eamon Mullan, Block Hotels Executive Chef from the Norioli, Nairobi, who together with Kathy Eldon compiled 'Tastes of Kenya' a recipe book of epicurean cuisine.

Interviewed at *Nyali Beach Hotel*, Eamon said he is hoping to include some locally made Foie Gras on the festive menu.

Other highlights will be quail, pheasants from Langata (ordered as early as June), milk-fed turkeys from the Nightingale Farm outside Nairobi, which will be served with chestnut stuffing and cranberry sauce.

Eamon, together with Julius Kamau, executive chef, *Nyali Beach Hotel*, has created an incentive gourmet menu for the *Mvita Grill* on New Year's Eve.

It will include pheasant pate with Cumberland sauce, and between the Saute of Lobster Nativion and Supreme of Duckling Montmorency, a Champagne Sorbet will be served to refresh the palate. Among the many gorgeous desserts will be Souffle Glace Grand Marnier.

FESTIVE FARE

Apart from spectacular and traditional festive fare, *Nyali Beach Hotel*'s entertainments programme swings into action on December 19 with a Fish Buffet and Jazz band, while on December 22 there is a 'Sing Along' combined with Happy Hour.

On Christmas Day, the Gala lunch on the *Mvita Terrace* will include a Jazz Band. On December 26, a Mexican Evening will be staged on the Pool Terrace, followed by a Fancy Dress competition in the Blues Disco.

A fashion show, and the mirth-making selection of 'Miss Nyali Beach Hotel' from male competitors takes place on December 29.

The theme on New Year's Eve will be '1001 Mombasa Nights' with dancing to the Mombasa Roots Band, 'shows from the island' and a fancy dress competition.

Mombasa Beach Hotel will

have three top bands playing there over the festive season. The Rafikis (its resident band) Midnight Savannah, and the African Heritage Band on December 26.

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LIKONI FERRY TRAFFIC

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meet the full cost of the work.

Approval from Central Government for this 'supplementary estimate' is still awaited, and the necessary money found.

Mr Tande mentioned that although the number of passengers using the Likoni Ferry had increased by 150 per cent, they were still being paid the same subsidy.

Consequently, they had been pressuring the Ministry of Transport & Communication for this to be increased.

The Likoni ferries carry an average of 66,000 passengers a day. The *Safina* can accommodate 50 cars and 1200 passengers, and the *Mvita* 32 cars and 900 passengers. The channel crossing takes 3-4 minutes.

He said that in 1981, Kenya Bus Services had commissioned professional Surveyors to draw up a plan for the expansion of the ferry service. This had been presented to Government in April 1981. Nothing had transpired.

In 1982, they had submitted a plan to Government on suggested pedestrian control as this traffic was expected to increase even further when the Tanzanian border re-opened.

Said Mr Tande 'although we have done everything possible, pedestrian traffic at peak hours is beyond our control.'

He also mentioned that it would be impossible to operate more than two ferries at a time with existing facilities.

In the meantime, the Kenya Government had proceeded with a feasibility study on the possibility of a bridge, or 'channel', to connect Mombasa with the south coast mainland.

During question time members pointed out that while some coxains are very helpful in controlling pedestrian traffic, others were not.

They felt that if all could be instructed to use the public address system and ask pedestrians to wait until the ferry is empty before embarking, this would be a great help.

Pedestrians should also be warned of the danger of walking in front of moving cars when disembarking.


